#### R20 curriculum course structure & syllabus for 2nd year

BoS Members have approved the structure & syllabus for II-year CST with the following suggestions/modifications.

- 1. The course structure of Digital Design with the credits of 2 was accepted without changes and introduction of Digital design laboratory in the curriculum were also accepted.
- 2. The course data structures & Design and Design and Analysis of Algorithms have been combined to a new course data structures and algorithm was accepted the members.
- 3. The modified syllabus of Database Systems and its laboratory with R18 syllabus were accepted by the members without modification.
- 4. The introduction of Corporate Communication Laboratory with 1 credit was accepted by the members.
- 5. The members accepted the following skill-oriented courses such as Programming in C++. Advanced C Programming, Introduction to Information Security (NPTEL), Data Science for Engineers (NPTEL) and recommended to append advanced courses in future.
- 6. The course structure of Computer Architecture as accepted by the members without modification.
- 7. The newly modified Network and Communication theory and laboratory replacing computer network theory and laboratory in R18 were accepted by the members.
- 8. The revised syllabus of Object-Oriented Programming Using Java theory and Laboratory were approved by the members.

- 3. The discipline elective IV tentative structure was modified and new course list with syllabus such as machine learning, Social Network Analysis, Cryptography and Network Security, Advanced Algorithms, Blockchain and Cryptocurrency were approved by the members.
- 4. The discipline elective V tentative structure was modified and new course list with Big Data Analytics, Test Driven Development, Augmented Reality and Virtual Reality, Wireless Network System, Programming Paradigms, Human Computer Interaction were approved by the members.

  - HoD and Vice Principal Academics all welcomed the External Experts and Internal faculty members for the Board of studies of Computer Science and Technology.
  - Members suggested to split the first unit of Formal Language Automata Theory. They recommended to shift from the topic pumping lemma to uniit-2, PFA to be included in unit-3. Turing machine syllabus has to reduced.
  - The course Computer Organization and Architecture was accepted without changes.
  - Board of Studies Experts requested to add the latest reference book with latest editions for all the courses.
  - The Board suggested modifications for the Computer Networks CN course. Mismatch in all the units. References are wrongly added to the course on Computer Networks.
  - The members accepted the syllabus for Software Engineering without any modifications.

- The members of the BOS suggested that maximum number of text books to be limited to two for any course.
- BOS members suggested to modify the syllabus for the course on AI Tools, Techniques
  and Applications. Many courses are integrated in one course. Hence they requested to
  Introduce the AI applications instead of all the theory and suggested to remove A\*
  algorithms, IP, and Deep Learning. Members requested to adjust and align the theory
  syllabus and lab syllabus properly.
- The syllabus for the course on Compiler Design was accepted by the members without
  modifications. But for Compiler Design Laboratory course, members requested to add the
  libraries from other languages instead of coding. They also suggested to incorporate the
  advanced technologies.
- In Discipline Elective I the members recommended to swap any other course instead of Adhoc Wireless Network from the other Discipline Elective list. The list of courses in Discipline Elective - II, Discipline Elective - III and Discipline Elective - IV were accepted by the members of the Board of Studies.
- For the Discipline Elective course on Data mining, members suggested to remove the syllabus after grid based methods. In UNIT-5 modify Advanced topics in data mining as Outlier Analysis. Remove multimedia part in UNIT-3 and stop at accuracy error methods. Remove constraint based association rule mining from syllabus. In UNIT-1 remove syllabus after data reduction.
- Members recommended to Change the text book for Mobile computing as Rajkamal.
   Please remove the last line from AI in unit-5.
- Adjust IOT syllabus by removing English sentences. Members suggested reference book for IOT can be made as as textbook.
- Members advised that the course on AI should be handled by two faculty members.
- The board approved the structure of Minor Degree Program with different schemes and syllabus existing in III Year, I and II Semesters of the B.Tech Programme.
- The structure of the Honors Degree was approved by the board.

- Members Suggested to incorporate Database Management System and Operating Systems in minor Degree program offered in the stream of Data Analytics.
- The members suggested to include the course on Block Chain Technologies in the Minor Program stream of Data Analytics.
- Board of Studies experts recommended to maintain a cap on the number of students opting Minor Degree stream.
