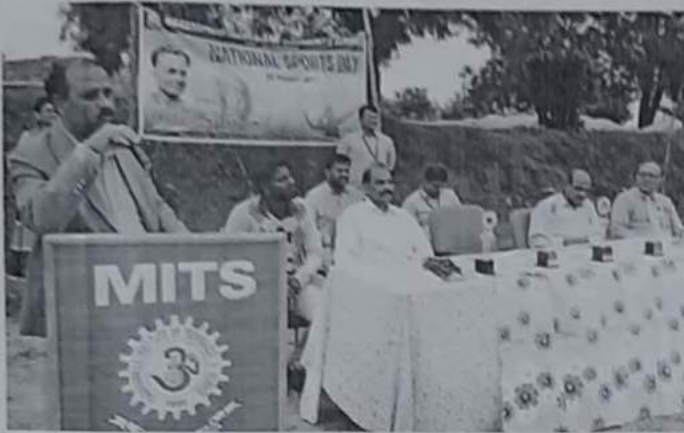

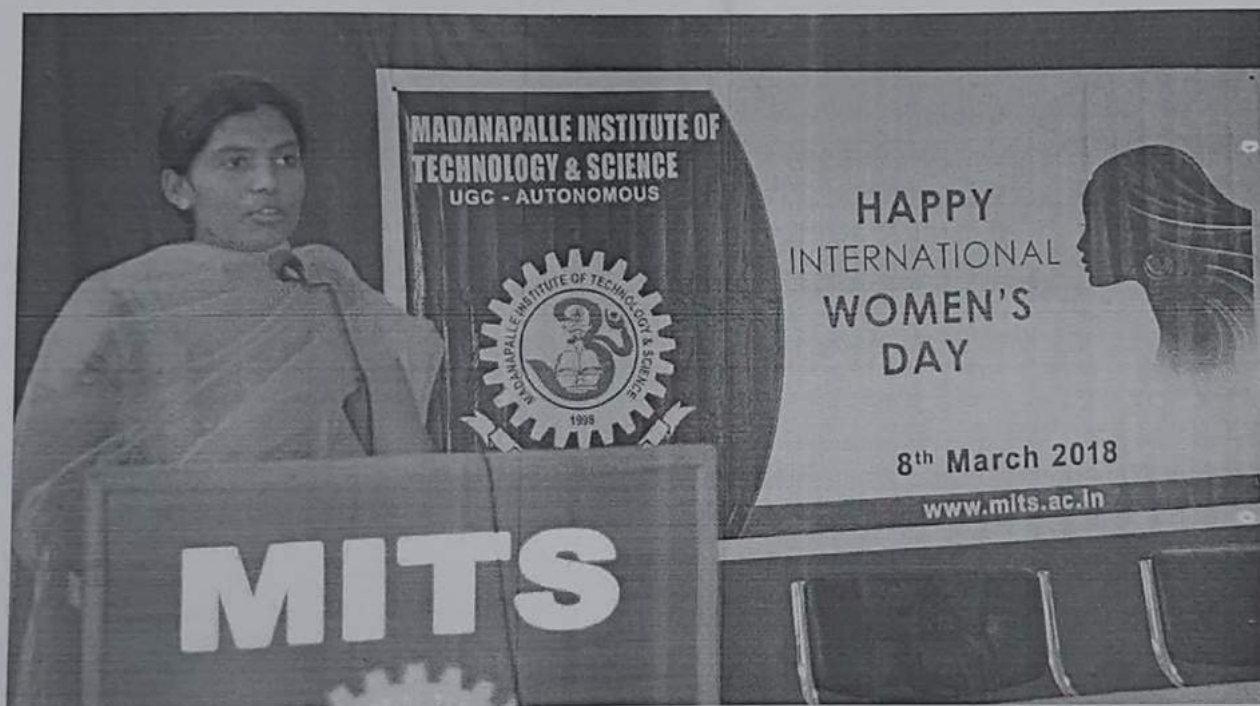

Dr.Geetha Devi, Chairperson of MITS-ICC greeted the women staff and the girl students, and she told about the MITS-ICC and how it addresses women issues.

Dr.G.Hampamma, Vice-Principal (Administration), while addressing the gathering told that the female population in Iceland enjoys rights and power on par with male. 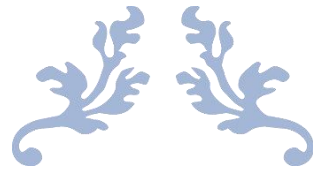
